#### Introduction

The Woodlands GREEN Scholarship Program awards cash scholarships each year to high school seniors residing in The Woodlands and nearby communities who exemplify a commitment to preserving the environment and who plan to continue their education or vocational training after graduation in an environmental field.

#### How much are Scholarships Worth?

Scholarship awards are up to \$1,000 each. Awards are sent directly to the student's school for the Fall Semester 2021.

#### Who is eligible?

Scholarship competition is open to students who meet the following criteria:

- 1. Must be a graduating senior in high schools servicing The Woodlands area and nearby communities including school districts: Conroe, Magnolia, Tomball and private schools within The Woodlands. Home school students are eligible.
- 2. Graduates in the spring following scholarship application.
- 3. Intends to attend an academic or vocational institution (i.e. 4-year bachelor's degree program, 2-year associate degree, trade school etc.)
- 4. Demonstrates a commitment to the environment both academically and through volunteering AND plans to further their studies in areas of: conservation, environmental sustainability, ecology, environmental policy, natural sciences, environmental engineering, natural resource management or related fields.
- 5. Degree plans, courses of study are outlined by the student.

#### How are winners selected?

Scholarship winners will be selected by a committee appointed by the Board of The Woodlands GREEN which may include non-members of the organization.

#### When to Apply

For the 2021 scholarship program, applications are accepted February 1-March 31, 2021.

#### **How to Apply**

- 1. Complete and sign the scholarship application. Forms can be downloaded from the Woodlands GREEN Website at <a href="https://www.thewoodlandsgreen.org">www.thewoodlandsgreen.org</a>.
- 2. Attach a maximum of two letters of recommendation.
- 3. Give the completed application to the high school guidance counselor for the school's certifying signature.
- 4. Send the completed application request form to The Woodlands GREEN to the attention of the Scholarship Program by March 31, 2021.

#### **Review Process**

- 1. After verifying the proof of residence and counselor certification, the scholarship application form will be forwarded to the Committee for review and scoring.
- 2. Awards will be announced in early May.
