Topic:

The En-ROADS simulator allows users to test strategies to address climate change via an interactive on-line tool. The simulator is over 10 years in the making, and has been co-developed by Climate Interactive and the MIT Sustainability Initiative. It is a hopeful, scientifically-grounded, peer-reviewed and action-oriented experience for anyone wanting to explore how human actions and government policies can impact the climate crisis. En-ROADS workshops have been run for the U.S. Congress, the Energy Transition Forum in London, HSBC bank, the U.S. Climate Action Network, the UN Secretary-General’s Office, and many others.

Roger will give an overview of the En-ROADS simulator and how it can be used as a role-play game, or a policy workshop. Attendees will be able to explore for themselves the consequences of energy choices, economic growth, land use, and other policies and uncertainties, with the goal of improving their understanding of the many factors impacting climate.
