**“Embracing Renewable Energy”
Conroe ISD’s Plan**

The Woodlands G.R.E.E.N. is sponsoring a Going Green Sustainability Lecture titled **“Embracing Renewable Energy-Conroe ISD’s Plan”** to be held via Zoom Thursday, January 21st, at 7:00 p.m. Mr. Easy Foster, Conroe Independent School District (CISD), will be our guest speaker. Topic: Mr. Foster will speak to the group about the new Stockton Jr. High School’s 1 MW solar array, how CISD came to the decision to do the project, and the district’s future renewable energy plans which include a second array which has recently broken ground at a future junior high school in east Montgomery County. Mr. Foster will be accompanied by the project’s consultants, LEAF Engineering.

Speaker: Mr. Easy Foster is currently the Director of Planning and Construction for Conroe Independent School District (CISD). He has worked with CISD in executing projects as a contractor and/or employee since 2006. In this role, Mr. Foster serves all students, faculty and staff in the planning and construction of safe, efficient and attractive facilities that meet educational needs, and are fiscally responsible. Mr. Foster received his B.S. in Construction Science from Texas A&M University and Masters in Management from Western Governors University. In addition to holding numerous other titles and licenses, he is a LEED (Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design) Accredited Professional. He currently serves as president of the Gulf Coast Chapter of the Association for Learning Environments. Accompanying Mr. Foster will be Mark Madorsky, President of LEAF Engineers and Brain Hood, Vice President. LEAF Engineers is the MEP (mechanical, electrical, and plumbing) Engineers of Record for both solar projects.
